Housing Solutions
Fact Sheet

Housing Solutions is a permanent supportive housing program for the chronically homeless. The program, created in 2006, is a nationwide initiative funded through grants provided by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The PNS program receives \$450,000 annually.

The Housing Solutions program is designed specifically for single clients who have a disability – mental or physical – or who are chronically homeless, those who have experienced homelessness for more than a year or have had four episodes of homelessness in three consecutive years.

Each month, clients transition out of our emergency shelter into permanent supportive housing with long-term case management and needed resources to maintain self-sufficiency.

The program's three main goals are to assist participants in obtaining and remaining in permanent housing, help clients increase life skills and income and help clients achieve greater self-confidence and determination to make healthy lifestyle choices.

The Housing Solutions program not only provides permanent housing but also offers financial management and budgeting assistance, educational classes, employment-related services, transportation access and life skills training.

Since its inception, the Housing Solutions program has helped 40 clients into permanent homes. The Shelter works with more than 17 apartment complexes in Tarrant County that are near a bus line.
